<p>Do <b>not</b> apply</p>	<p>if your charity is outside the UK or its main focus is supporting overseas operations;</p> <p>if you are not a registered charity;</p> <p>if your charity is the subject of any regulatory investigation;</p> <p>for historic operational or capital deficits;</p> <p>for routine operational costs;</p> <p>for shul projects – premises purchase or redevelopment;</p> <p>for summer camps and after-school playschemes.</p>
<p>Please <b>remember</b>.....</p>	<p>that only one application per charity or associated charities will be considered;</p> <p>to read carefully, and act upon, the guidelines above before developing your submission;</p> <p>we will carefully consider your application, - if you are successful at this initial stage, we will work with you to assist you in implementing your plans.</p>
